Advice for Life and the 3 Ps (Prevention, Protection, Prosecution)

A combination of partnership projects that provide advice, information, counselling, training, employment, guidance and mentoring services.

Services provided under partnership projects:

Advice and Information in Farsi, Turkish, Kurdish, English and Arabic

Providing confidential and specialist face to face, telephone and outreach advice in violence against women in particular 'honour' based violence, forced marriages, female genital mutilation, housing, and welfare benefits.

Counselling in Farsi, English and Kurdish

Providing short and long term counselling and making appropriate referrals where needed.

Training & Awareness Raising Seminars/Conferences

Providing training and awareness raising seminars and conferences in 'honour' based violence, forced marriages and female genital mutilation to both professionals and community members.

Employment Advice, Guidance and Mentoring

Providing face to face and group sessions employment advice and information, guidance and mentoring to refugee women.
